Work Projects:

- Paint bunks in the girls dorm.
- General maintenance and clean up

Tools To Bring:

Lodging:

- There are several buildings with beds. Some are in private rooms, some are dorm-style. Bring your own bedding and linens.
- Full RV hook-ups..

Food:

- The camp will provide and prepare all the meals for the SWAT Team at no charge. We need to know how many to prepare for. Therefore it is imperative that you let us know at which meals you will be present.
- Bring your own snacks or special diet foods.

Directions to VA Camp

1151 High School Rd, Buckingham, VA 23921

Be sure to take your GPS or a Virginia map with you for this trip!!!

From Raleigh:

- 1. Take Creedmoor Rd (Rt 50) north to Creedmoor. Get on Rt 15 north.
- 2. Stay on Rt 15 north all the way to Sprouces Corner, VA, (just east of Buckingham, VA)
- 3. Rt 15 winds around and you will have to make several turns in order to stay on Rt 15. It merges with other routes from time to time so be very alert. It is easy to miss a turn and find yourself on some other route. Be sure to take a map with you.
- 4. Eventually you will arrive at Sprouces Corner. Turn left onto Rt 60 (trafic light). Go ½ mile and turn right onto High School Rd.
- 5. Go ¼ mile and turn right into the Camp. The High School will be on your left.

From Greensboro:

- 1. Take Rt 29 north to Danville, VA.
- 2. Continue on Rt 29 to Lynchburg
- 3. Continue on Rt 29 to Amherst, VA..
- 4. At Amherst take Rt 60 East. Go about 15 miles and go through Bent Creek.
- 5. Go 13 miles and go through Mt Rush.
- 6. Go 4 miles and go all the way through Buckingham. Continue on towards Sprouces Corner for about 3 miles. Just before you get to Sprouces Corner turn left onto High School Rd.
- 7. Go ¼ mile and turn right into the Camp. The High School will be on your left.
